If coming from E / NE on KANSAS TURNPIKE – exit north of El Dorado onto Highway 77.

If coming from W / SW on KANSAS TURNPIKE – exit west of El Dorado onto Highway 254 – West Central Avenue.

If coming from N on Highway 81 / I135, take Rte 196 east from exit 25.

The BUTLER COUNTY COMMUNITY BUILDING is in Central Park, on the east side of Griffith St.

El Dorado was the center of an early 20th Century “oil boom.” The Kansas Oil Museum (open May through September??) includes a recreated 1920s oil boom town, with period buildings moved from “ghost towns.” It is just a couple of blocks south of the meeting site.
